Born March 22, 1914, Kaye grew up in Creelman, Saskatchewan. She took nurse's training at the Ontario Hospital School of Nursing in Hamilton. After the Dieppe disaster, she felt compelled to enlist in 1943 with the Royal Canadian Army Medical Corps. Kaye went overseas in 1944, serving with the No. 20 and No. 7 Canadian General Hospitals in England, Belgium and Italy. She married Donald Allan in 1951 and they lived in Prince George, B.C. until 1971, when they moved to Invermere and Kaye retired from nursing. Their children are Gordon, Barry, and Helen. Kaye died Dec. 28, 2011.
