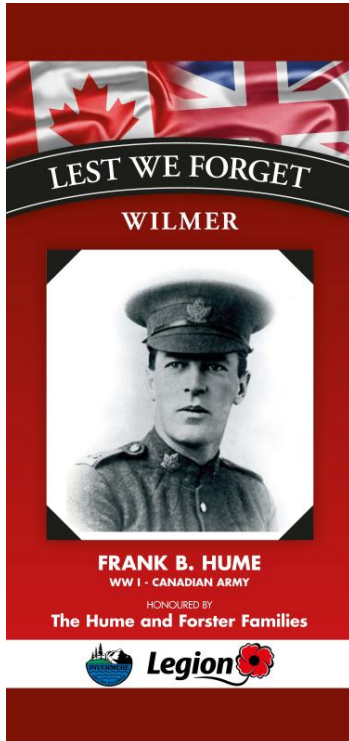


† HUME, FRANK BROGDEN



Born Sept. 5, 1883 in Galt, Ontario, Frank arrived here as a teenager with his parents, who managed Firlands Ranch. He earned his engineering degree in Scotland in 1904, then returned and married Ada. Son Gavin was born in 1909. Frank enlisted in 1916, and became a Sergeant in the Canadian Infantry's Forty-Seventh Battalion, along with younger brother Jack. Shot by a sniper at Passchendaele, Frank was helped to an ambulance by his brother. The brothers were then separated, and Frank later died of his wounds on Oct. 31, 1917. Frank is buried at Poperinghe, Belgium and his name appears on the Invermere Cenotaph.
