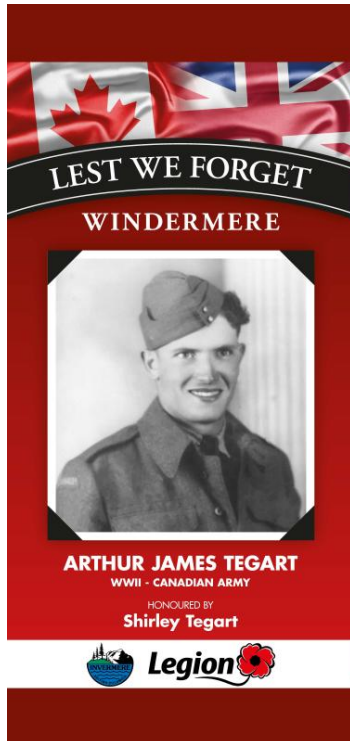


TEGART, ARTHUR JAMES
