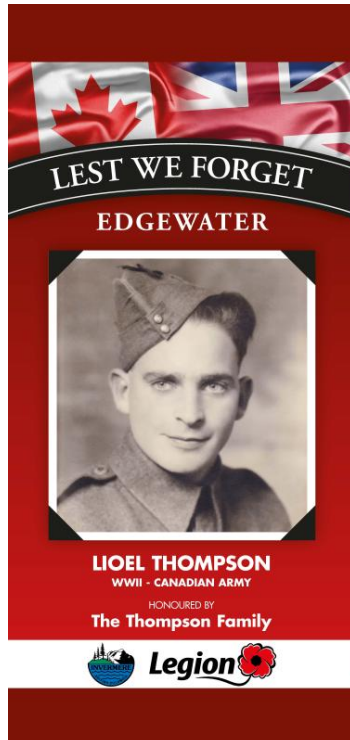


THOMPSON, LIOEL



Lioel was born May 19, 1920 at Thompson Landing, across the river from Edgewater. He enlisted in the Canadian Army with his brother Jack and served as a tank mechanic in England and Europe. He married Frances in England in 1944. Lioel had started guiding hunters at age 16, and after the war he worked as a guide outfitter until 1962. He and his wife managed the Royal Antler Ranch in the 1950s, and he also worked in construction and forestry. They had three children: David, Doris, and Roy. Lioel belonged to the Range Patrol, the Anglican Church and the Legion. He died Nov. 7, 1994.
