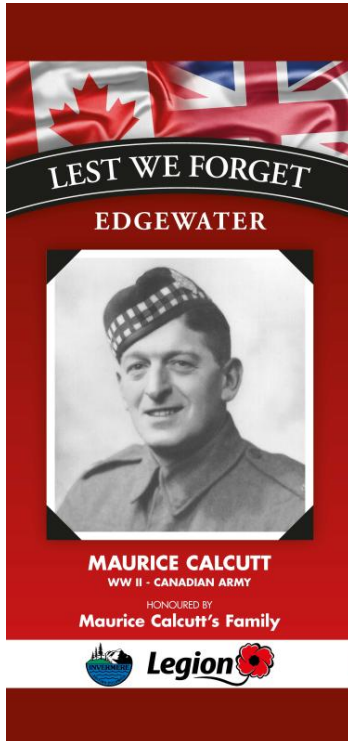


## CALCUTT, MAURICE THOMAS



Born in Surrey, England on May 24, 1904, Maury immigrated on his own in 1920 at the age of 16 to Edgewater, where he lived until 1963. In 1928 he married Catherine and they had four children: Elizabeth, Amy, Robert, and Patricia. Maury enlisted in the Canadian Army in 1940. He was transferred to the Royal Canadian Engineers in 1942 and was highly rated as an equipment operator. He arrived in France on D-Day. After the war Maury worked for Parks Canada for many years. In 1952, he married Irene. They retired to Victoria in 1966, and Maury died Oct. 5, 1991.
