Natt was born Oct. 17, 1924 in Calgary. After finishing high school, he served in the Royal Canadian Air Force from 1943 to 1946. He was turned down as a pilot due to his hearing, but was accepted for aircrew training and instructed Mosquito aircrews. After his discharge, he graduated from Queen's University in Toronto as a geological engineer and worked for Gulf Oil for many years. He married Martha and they had four children: Paula-Marie, Nat, Philip, and Carla-Jo. The couple moved to the Columbia Valley in 1985 and lived at Larch Point. Natt died Nov. 5, 1995.
