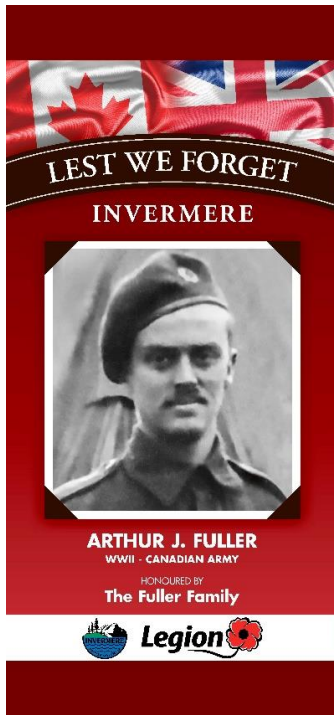


## FULLER, ARTHUR J.

During World War Two, Art served with No. 26 Company of the Canadian Forestry Corps (the Sawdust Fusiliers) in Scotland, harvesting lumber for the war effort. Art was a civil engineer who was employed by the Village of Invermere most of his life. He died June 9, 1963 in Invermere.
