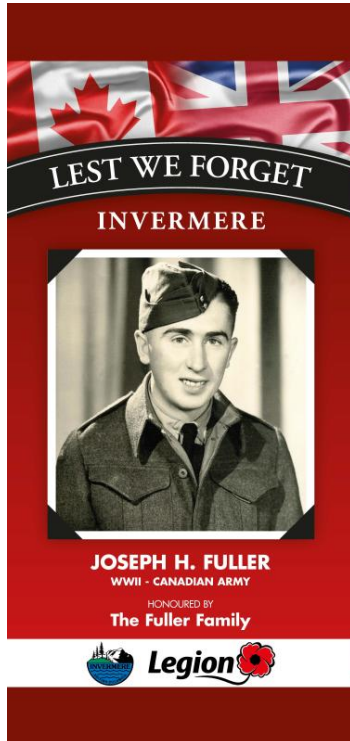


FULLER, JOSEPH HENSMAN
