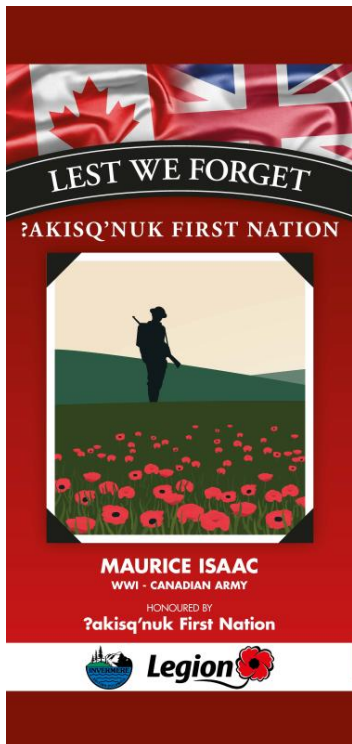


ISAAC, MAURICE JOSEPH



Maurice was born on July 22, 1894 and was a member of the Columbia Lake Band, also known as the Akisqnuq Band. He enlisted in the Canadian Army in World War One and served overseas in Scotland as a Private in the Canadian Forestry Corps, also known as the Sawdust Fusiliers, which harvested lumber in the forests of Scotland to be used for the war effort. His wife was Ann Mary from the St. Mary's Band near Cranbrook. Maurice died Nov. 7, 1921 at Findlay Creek, leaving behind his wife and two children. He was just twenty-seven years old.
