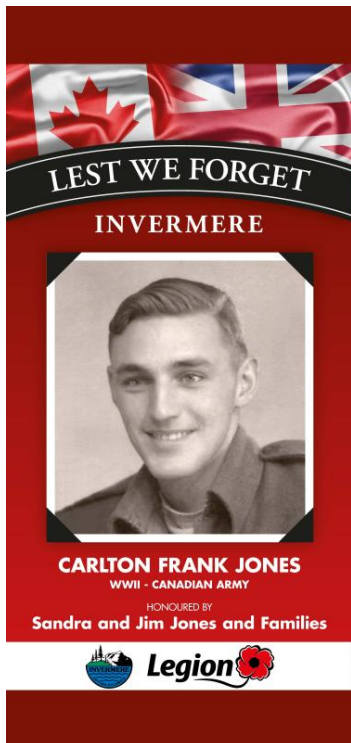


JONES, CARLTON (CARL) FRANK



Carl was born in Invermere Nov. 30, 1921. He joined the Canadian Army with brother Jack in 1940, and served in Scotland harvesting lumber with the Canadian Forestry Corps. In Europe, he participated in the 1944 Battle of the Bulge. After the war he married Marion and had children Sandra, Suzanne, and Jim. Carl was both mechanic and trucker, and owned two ranches – one on the site of the current Invermere high school, and another south of town overlooking Lake Windermere. A lifelong athlete, Carl coached track and field, and hockey. His greatest love was his eleven grandchildren. He died March 16, 1995.
