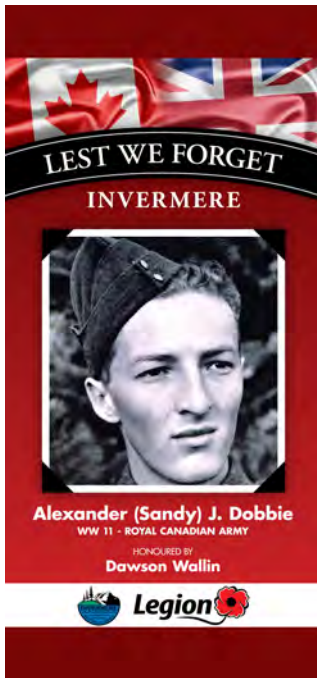


DOBBIE, ALEXANDER (SANDY) J



Sandy was born in Invermere on February 28, 1922. He joined the Royal Canadian Army in 1949. He served with the Canadian Forestry Corps in Scotland before being transferred to Continental Europe in Holland, Brussels, and Belgium. He was discharged in 1945. After the war Sandy drove truck, hauling ore for the Paradise Mine. In the early 1950's, he contracted polio, which left his legs in braces. He subsequently kept books for Tommy Foyston and the Invermere Hardware. Sandy was an avid hockey player, guide and horseman. He was a passionate outdoorsman with a special love for the sport of rodeo. He died August 4, 1966.
