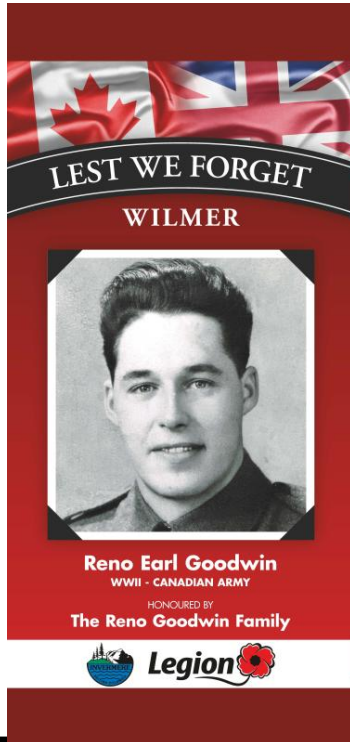


GOODWIN, RENO EARL
