
JIMMY, MOSES



Moses was born Feb. 4, 1916, a member of the Columbia Lake Band, also known as the Akisqnuk Band. He served with the Canadian Army as a gunner in World War Two. After the war he returned to the valley and worked as a logger. He kept a journal and was an excellent writer, with above average grammar. He was also very talented in the craft of leatherwork, creating many handbags and belts. He was survived by one daughter in Spokane, Washington, and several grandchildren.

Moses died in Vancouver on June 7, 1984.
