


MCINTOSH, DUNCAN GILBERT



Born in Abbey, Saskatchewan on Oct. 1, 1919, Duncan joined the Royal Canadian Air Force in 1941 and was discharged in 1945. He married Dorothy and their children were Douglas, Bruce, and Patricia. After the war, he and his family owned and operated Golden's Big Bend Hotel, followed by the Bow Theatre in Bowness, Alberta. In 1952 the family returned to the valley and opened Radium Hot Springs Lodge. They also established and operated Radium's Drive-In Theatre. Duncan died in Invermere on March 19, 1999.
