


## MICHEL, ISADORE



Isadore was born on March 1, 1914, the son of Lucy and Pete Michel. He was a member of the Columbia Lake Band, also known as the Akisqnuq Band. He attended St. Eugene Residential School near Cranbrook. In September 1939 he volunteered with the Canadian Army. His ship was quarantined due to scarlet fever, and he arrived in Scotland several months later. He served with the Canadian Forestry Corps in Scotland, and in 1944 he was shipped to Europe and witnessed the surrender of Germany. Isadore never married, but after the war he received a Veterans Land Act grant and homesteaded at Columbia Lake.
