
RICHER, WINNIFRED (FOSTER)



Winnie was born a Cockney on March 7, 1923 in London, England. She came to Canada in the 1930s and served in Halifax as a WREN (Women's Royal Canadian Naval Service). After the war Winnie married Leo Richer and they moved to Windermere, raising Roger and Sherry. Winnie was a homemaker and businesswoman, owning Richer's General Store and Post Office with her husband from 1963 to 1975. Winnie was a whiz at crossword puzzles and Scrabble. She volunteered with the hospital auxiliary, organized many bingos, and made costumes for the local theatre group. She died Aug. 7, 1993.
