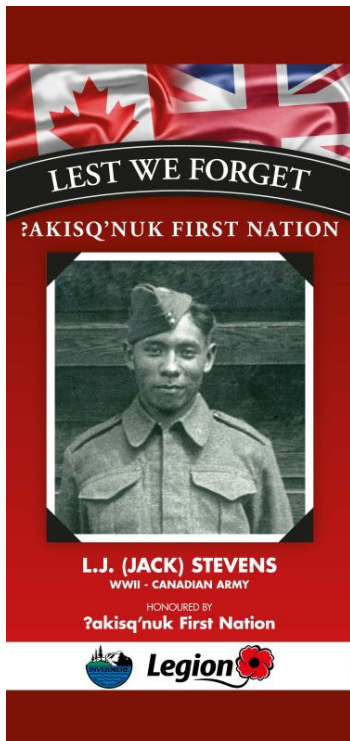


## STEVENS, LAWRENCE JOHN (JACK)



Jack was born on Jan. 3, 1922 at Tobacco Plains near Grasmere, B.C., part of the Ktunaxa Nation. He spent most of his life at Columbia Lake Reserve. After enlisting in the Canadian Army, he served overseas and was part of the force that liberated Holland. Jack was considered one of the best sawyers in the valley. His real love was sports – he was a rodeo bronco rider, and a legend on the baseball field. Married twice, he fathered Basil, Millie, Lola, Richard, Peter, Donna, Terry, John, Sandra, Yvonne, Russell, Elaine, and Roberta. Known as Papa Jack, he also coached championship baseball teams. He died on Nov. 27, 1988.
