Born in Cirencester, England on Oct. 28, 1912, Nancy Lee moved to her aunt's ranch in Edgewater as a teenager. She then worked in Vancouver, pumping gas and parking cars. In 1942 she joined the Royal Canadian Air Force and was posted to England where she drove a three-tonne supply truck. Nancy returned to Canada in 1946. She married Lloyd Tegart in 1958 and they purchased Hidden Valley Ranch. After he died accidentally in 1967, Nancy continued to ranch on her own, then moved to another ranch near Windermere. Nancy drove her own truck well into her nineties. She died in 2012.
